ANNUAL REPORT 2018-19

1. About college:

College of Agriculture, Ambajogai is a constituent college of Vasantrao Naik Marathwada Krishi Vidyapeeth, Parbhani which is established in the year 2000 by the Govt. of Maharashtra to cater the need of agriculture education at graduation level in the region of Marathwada.

The college has self content campus spread over an area of 42 ha comprising the college building, hostel for boys and girls, play grounds, instructional farm, crop cafeteria, demonstration farm, horticultural fruit crops orchard, medicinal and aromatic plant plots, polyhouse and shed net houses, yoga park and college canteen etc.

The college campus is located on the outskirt of the city on Ambajogai-Beed road. College run the graduation programme in agricultural science. Each year 60 students are admitted to the graduation programme through Maharashtra Council of Agricultural Education and Research (MCAER), Pune.

2. Education:

2.1 Admission process

There were three rounds of admission + a spot round of UG admission. The admission process was completed from 26/07/2018 to 30/08/2018. The distribution of category wise admitted candidates is given below in(Table 1).
