1. About college:

College of Agriculture, Ambajogai is a constituent college of Vasantao Naik Marathwada Krishi Vidyapeeth, Parbhani which is established in the year 2000 by the Govt. of Maharashtra to cater the need of agriculture education at graduation level in this region of Marathwada.

The college has self contained campus spread over an area of 42.00 ha comprising the college building, hostel for boys and girls, play grounds, instructional farm, crop cafeteria, demonstration farm, horticultural fruit crops orchard, medicinal and aromatic plant plots, polyhouse and shed net houses, yoga park and college canteen etc.

The college campus is located on the outskirts of the city on Ambajogai-Beed road. College runs the graduation programme in agricultural science. Each year 60 students are admitted to the graduation programme through Maharashtra Council of Agricultural Education and Research, Pune.

All the semesters of Academic Year 2021-22 were run on online virtual mode due to Covid-19 pandemic situation. Theory and practical classes, examinations viz., mid-term, semester end theory as well as practicals were conducted by online mode due to covid situation.

2. Education:

2.1 Admission process

There were three rounds of admission along with spot round for UG admission. The admission process was completed from 06/12/2021 to 30/12/2021. The distribution of category wise admitted candidates is given below in (Table 1).
